

# WEST LRT UPDATE

The City of Calgary's West LRT status report

January 2010



## Design-Build Update

- The design builder will complete the soil and ground condition investigation in January.
- Survey work is underway and is scheduled for completion in January.

## Sunalta Station Area

One commercial building removal will occur in January.

## Westbrook Station Area

One commercial building removal will occur in January.

## 45 Street Station Area

- Removal of the commercial building on the corner of 45<sup>th</sup> Street and 17<sup>th</sup> Avenue S.W. will occur in January.
- The City will relocate the Calgary Police sign in January.

## Sirocco Station Area

- The City is working with the Community Association to find a new location for the Signal Hill community sign. The City is removing it in January and it will remain in storage until a new location is found.
- Water Services will install water valves on Sarcee Trail that will require some lane restrictions in January.

## 69 Street Station Area

- The parkade excavation and grading is complete.
- Subcontractor bidding for the parkade construction occurs in January.

## West Calgary High School

- The existing Ernest Manning High School playing fields are required for construction. The High School will use playing fields in the communities of Killarney and Signature Park to accommodate their physical education and athletics programs from March 2010 to June 2011.
- The high school building at 69<sup>th</sup> Street S.W. will be completely enclosed in January, including windows.
